About Us

The Buena Vista Event Cooperative, or BVEC, is a local non-profit 501(c)(3) organization that facilitates free live music, arts, and community events.

BVEC started with Tom Rollings around 2016 with free concerts at the BV Roastery on East Main. After seeing the overwhelming joy it brought the community, he started on a big idea to make it more sustainable. Tom started the Legacy Stage at McPhelemy Park initiative in earnest in 2021. With the partnership of the Town of BV and the Chamber of Commerce, over \$100,000 was raised in 2022, with stage construction starting in August of 2022. The stage was dedicated June 3, 2023 with its Grand Opening.

Our Mission: The Buena Vista Event Cooperative brings free live music to the community while ensuring fair compensation for artists. Through collaboration and community support, we strive to foster the growth of musical and visual arts, enriching the cultural fabric of our community.
